Proposed new concept for future meetings

I propose that on the Tuesday before a ZOOM meeting an email be sent with the link to the meeting and the actual information that we want all members to take in before we hold a discussion at the ZOOM meeting to discuss points and questions sent in the meeting notice one week prior to the meeting being held.

Reasons for the change are:

- Often one or more of us has a poor internet connection and we do not get to participate in the meeting.
- The content of the meeting sent prior to the ZOOM meeting will allow all to download content at their internet speed at their leisure during the week prior to the ZOOM meeting
- The meeting notice can be uploaded in its entirety to our website so that it is available from the website both for our own members, visiting Rotarians doing make-ups and interested members of the public.
- The meeting notice will fulfil our obligation to D9700 to serve as our newsletter

Format of Meetings:

- **Welcome**
- **Rotary Message** – something obtained from your browsing the internet about Rotary that you would like to share with all of us.
- **Main message** – which can be a Guest Speaker and presentation, a powerpoint presentation, a video, a quiz, a competition, a link to a video guest speaker on a topic of general interest or Rotary, an article and pictures of general interest, a photo or video presentation on a holiday. Really it will be a subject of your choice and material can be easily sourced from the internet.
- **Questions** on the main message that you ask us all to consider before they are discussed at the ZOOM meeting. This will form a discussion point at the ZOOM meeting. Visitors doing a make-up will be asked to answer those questions when submitting their make-up.
- **Personal Comment** - a short, written comment on something about "you" or something "you" have done that others may not be aware of. This might be changed once we have all contributed.
- **End of Meeting** – Thanking all for attendance. Members who attend the ZOOM meeting will be recorded by the Secretary. Members who do not attend the meeting can register their attendance on our website. Visitors to our website can record their makeup and deposit a donation into our Service account that will be contributed to the Rotary Foundation

I propose that as President I will plan the meeting held on the second Tuesday each month and all other members will rotate the responsibility of organising the meeting for the fourth Tuesday of each month.
